**PUBLIC NOTICE ON INDICATIVE AND CAP PRICES FOR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN
THE COUNTRY EFFECTIVE 02ND MARCH 2011**

EWURA hereby publishes bi-weekly indicative and cap prices for petroleum products in the Tanzania Mainland local market. These retail and wholesale prices are applicable effective **Wednesday, 02nd March 2011**. Kindly take note of the following.

- (a) Petroleum products retail and wholesale prices for all products, in the Tanzania Mainland local market have increased compared with the last prices publications of 16th February 2011. Retail prices have increased as follows: Petrol 1.01%, Diesel 2.80% and Kerosene 4.52%. The prices increase has been caused by changes in the world market prices and depreciation of the Tanzanian Shilling compared to the US dollar (the currency in which purchases of products in the international oil market are made). Increase in wholesale prices for the same period is as follows: Petrol 1.05%, Diesel 2.90% and Kerosene 4.74%.
- (b) In line with the prevailing sector legislation, prices of petroleum products are governed by rules of supply and demand. EWURA shall continue to encourage competition in the sector by making available petroleum products pricing information including price cap. This information on prices is intended to enable stakeholders to make informed decisions on petroleum prices at any particular time.
- (c) Oil marketing companies are free to sell their products at a price that give them competitive advantage, provided that such **price does not exceed the price cap for the relevant product**. The price cap has been set at 7.5 per cent of the indicative price as computed by EWURA in accordance with the approved formula. **The approved formula was gazetted through Government Notice No. 5 of 9th January 2009.**
- (d) All petrol stations should publish petroleum product prices on clearly visible boards. The price boards should be clearly visible and should clearly show prices charged, discounts offered as well as any trade incentives or promotions on offer. Consumers are advised to purchase from those that sell products at the most competitive prices. **It is an offence not to have prices published on boards located in clearly visible places in front of petrol stations and it will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**
- (e) Following review of the standard of diesel that was made by TBS in consultation with EWURA and other stakeholders, effective 1st January 2011, diesel sold in the Tanzania local market shall have a maximum of 500 ppm sulphur. **Selling or offering for sale diesel of higher sulphur content is an offence and will attract punitive measures from EWURA.**
- (f) Retailers must issue receipts with respect to all sales that they make and consumers are advised to **demand and keep receipts** that clearly show the name of petrol station, date on which such

purchase was made as well as, the type of fuel and price per litre for every purchase they make. This can be used as an exhibit in case of a complaint lodged in the event that the selling price is above the cap price or in case the products sold is off the approved specifications
