NOTICE*(Made under section 19(4))*THE ENERGY AND WATER UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY
(COMMENCEMENT OF THE INQUIRY ON THE NEW PETROLEUM
PRICING FORMULA) NOTICE, 2011

1. This Notice may be cited as the Energy and Water Utilities
Regulatory Authority (Commencement of the Inquiry on the New
Petroleum Pricing Formula) Notice, 2011.

Citation

2. In this Notice, unless the context otherwise requires—
“bulk procurement system” means the petroleum procurement system
prescribed under the Petroleum (Bulk Procurement) Regulations;
“discussion paper” means a paper prepared by the Authority with details on
the subject matter of the inquiry and which stakeholders and members
of the public shall discuss and give comments before the public hearing
meeting and shall include the timeline for the entire process;
“inquiry” means the process of collecting views from stakeholders in
relation to the new petroleum pricing formula;
“public hearing meeting” means the meeting to be convened by the
Authority on the 06th day of December, 2011 or any other subsequent
date to discuss on the new petroleum pricing formula.

Purpose of inquiry 3. The purpose of the inquiry is to enable the Authority to properly determine petroleum prices by using the new petroleum pricing formula for petroleum products in accordance with the requirements of the bulk procurement system.

Participation in inquiry 4. A person may participate in the inquiry by submitting his recommendation in writing to the Director-General within two weeks from the publication of this Notice and in a manner specified in paragraph 8 of the Notice.

Intervention to the inquiry 5.—(1) A person who is an interested party to the inquiry and who wishes to intervene in that inquiry shall register with the Authority before the public hearing meeting.

(2) A person referred to under sub-paragraph (1) of this paragraph shall, upon registration, be allowed to make presentations at the public hearing meeting and shall be entitled to be furnished with copies of all materials relating to the inquiry.

Imposition of fees 6. The Authority shall impose fees for any intervention made by an interested party at the rate to be determined by the Authority to cover operational costs.

Discussion papers 7.—(1) Copies of the discussion paper and other related documents shall be available for collection from the 11th day of November, 2011, at the offices of the Authority during official hours.

(2) The electronic version of the discussion paper shall be available and downloaded from the website of the Authority.

(3) For purposes of this paragraph, “official working hours” means the hours between 09.00 am and 05. 00 pm
